Restore Lake Pedder was the focus of attention at the Australian Federal parliament today. As the words Restore Lake Pedder, emblazoned the sky with several laps of Parliament house completing the action that Brenda Hean and Max Price lost their lives undertaking in 1972.

“In this the UN Decade on Ecosystem Restoration it’s a great opportunity for the Australian Government to nominate the restoration of Lake Pedder as Australia’s flagship project.” Said Christine Milne, convenor Lake Pedder Restoration Inc.

“On international women's day it's fantastic to hear Senator Nick McKim pay tribute to the courageous women who have campaigned for Pedder for 50 years and the next generation of young women who continue to do so.” said Tabatha Badger, Restore Padder Campaign Coordinator.

The 8th of March is also the anniversary of the 1955 declaration of the Lake Pedder National Park.
